

RESOLUTION NO. 2011-356

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA RESTATING THE COUNTY'S LONG TERM OBJECTIVES OF THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PLAN AND IMPLEMENTING THE SHORT TERM OBJECTIVES FOR THE SILVER CREEK ASSISTED LIVING FACILITY.

WHEREAS, Based on the 2000 U.S. Census, the County's population is 123,135. Of the 123,135 residents, 9,698 or 8% are below the poverty level.

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners held public hearings on October 4, 2011 and November 15, 2011 and authorized the submission of a CDBG Small Cities Economic Development application to the Department of Economic Opportunity for the Silver Creek Assisted Living Facility;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

The County shall implement the following objectives:

LONG TERM OBJECTIVES:

1. To improve the physical environment of the community to make it more functional, safe, and efficient and to preserve the integrity of the neighborhood.
2. To promote the public interest.
3. To inject long range considerations into the determination of short range decisions.
4. To bring professional and technical knowledge to bear on issues concerning social, economical, or physical development.
5. To facilitate effective cooperation and coordination between all concerned with community development.
6. To identify all available resources for major opportunities and to improve the way of life for all in the community.


SHORT TERM OBJECTIVES:

1. To apply for Community Development Block Grant funds in the Economic Development category to construct a lift station force main, roadway improvements, sidewalk improvements and electrical service upgrades required for the development of the proposed Silver Creek Assisted Living Facility within St. Johns County.

2. To explore other possible resources for the purpose of improving the way of life for all citizen's, especially those who live in deteriorated housing and neighborhoods.
3. To the extent that there are typographical and/or administrative errors and/or omissions that do not change the tone, tenor, or context of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without the subsequent approval of the Board of County Commissioners.
