

RESOLUTION 2012 - 186

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2012 GENERAL FUND/ANIMAL CONTROL DEPARTMENT TO RECEIVE UNANTICIPATED DONATIONS AND AUTHORIZE ITS EXPENDITURE TO ENHANCE THE ANIMAL CONTROL OPERATIONS IN FY 2012.

WHEREAS, St. Johns County, Florida, when preparing the budget for Fiscal Year 2012 did not have appropriate donations made for use by the St. Johns County Animal Control Department; and

WHEREAS, as of July 17, 2012, an additional \$10,378 in unrestricted donations made to the St. Johns County Animal Control Department have been received; and


WHEREAS, St. Johns County Animal Control needs to recognize the donations in order to authorize its expenditure for St. Johns County Animal Control Department operational enhancements within FY 2012;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that:


1. The above recitals are hereby adopted as legislative findings of fact.
2. The General Fund and Animal Control Department expenditure budgets shall be adjusted to account for unanticipated funds in the amount of \$10,378.
