

RESOLUTION NO. 2014- 167

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF FUNDING FROM THE ELKTON DRAINAGE DISTRICT FUND RESERVES TO THE ELKTON DRAINAGE DISTRICT OPERATING FUND TO ADDRESS ADDITIONAL MAINTENANCE NEEDS BEYOND ANNUAL MAINTENANCE COSTS.

WHEREAS, the transfer of \$2,500 from the Elkton Drainage District Fund Reserves for use in additional maintenance of the Parker Canal is desired; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY has reviewed the estimated costs for maintenance and has determined that the funding requested is sufficient to accomplish this task; and

WHEREAS, The transfer of Elkton Drainage District funds is for a maintenance effort that is consistent and in accordance with the guidelines and provisions as established within the District; and

WHEREAS, Engaging in the project is in the best interests of the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The above recitals are hereby incorporated into the body of this Resolution, and are adopted as Findings of Fact.

Section 2. The Board of County Commissioners authorizes the County Administrator, or designee, to execute any other paperwork associated with, or necessary to accomplish, the overall goal set forth as part of the subject project.

Section 3. The Board approves the transfer of \$2,500 from the Elkton Drainage District Fund Reserves to the Elkton Drainage District Operations Fund, and authorizes its expenditure for the desired objective.

Section 4. To the extent that there are typographical or administrative errors that do not change the tenor, or concept of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without subsequent approval of the Board of County Commissioners.


Section 5. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.


