

RESOLUTION NO: 2016- 141

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO AWARD AND EXECUTE TASK ORDERS UNDER BID NO: 12-66 AND 14-48 FOR THE FY 2016 PAVEMENT MANAGEMENT PROGRAM.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the County desires to issue task orders to Asphalt Paving Systems, Inc, Hubbard Construction Company, to perform asphalt maintenance services, and Southern States Pavement Markings, Inc to perform striping services for the St. Johns County Engineering Department; and

WHEREAS, the County issued Bid No: 16-03 for the Pavement Management Program, and the bids received were over budget and subsequently rejected; and

WHEREAS, the County has established unit prices with all three (3) vendors, through continuing contract; and

WHEREAS, the contract is being funded by the SJC Engineering Department; and

WHEREAS, the County has reviewed the terms, provisions, conditions and requirements of the proposed task orders (attached hereto, an incorporated herein) and finds that issuing the task orders serves a public purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

Section 1. The above Recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution and such Recitals are adopted as finds of fact.

Section 2. The County Administrator, or designee, is hereby authorized to award task orders to Asphalt Paving Systems, Inc and Hubbard Construction Company under Bid No: 12-66, and Southern States Pavement Markings, Inc under Bid No: 14-48;

Section 3. The County Administrator, or designee, is further authorized to execute task orders in substantially the same form and format as attached hereto to Asphalt Paving Systems, Inc, Hubbard Construction Company, and Southern States Pavement Markings, Inc on behalf of the County for asphalt maintenance and striping services as specifically provided in the Bid Documents for Bid No 12-66 and 14-48.

Section 4. To the extent that there are typographical and/or administrative errors that do not change the tone, tenor, or concept of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without subsequent approval by the Board of County Commissioners.
