

RESOLUTION NO. 2016- 93

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE AMENDMENT NO. 6 TO DEP CONTRACT RP730 TO PROVIDE WATER SURVEILLANCE AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE TO ANASTASIA STATE RECREATION AREA FOR PEAK SUMMER SEASON.

WHEREAS, on May 17, 2011, St. Johns County (the County) entered into DEP Contract No. RP730 (the Contract) with the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection (the State) to provide lifeguards from the County to provide water surveillance and emergency response to Anastasia State Recreation Area for peak summer season between Memorial Day weekend and Labor Day weekend; and

WHEREAS, the Contract provides that the State may increase the funding amount of the Contract from year to year based on satisfactory performance and annual appropriations by the Legislature; and

WHEREAS, the State has elected to increase the funding amount of the Contract from \$230,459.90 to \$271,099.76 (an increase of \$40,639.86) to cover the period of service from May 27, 2016 to September 5, 2016; and


WHEREAS, the County has determined that amending the Contract will serve a public purpose.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County:

1. The above recitals are incorporated herein by reference and adopted as finding of fact in support of this resolution.
2. The County Administrator, or his designee, is authorized to execute Amendment No. 6 to DEP Contract No. RP730 (attached) to increase the funding increment amount to the Contract.
3. To the extent that there are typographical or administrative errors that do not change the tone, tenor, or concept of this resolution, this resolution may be revised without subsequent approval by the Board of County Commissioners.
4. This resolution shall be effective upon adoption by the St. Johns County Board of County Commissioners.

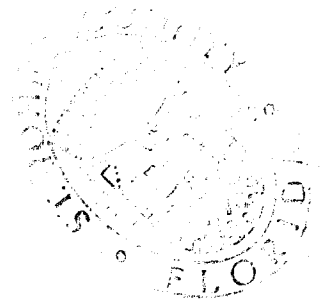

**DEP CONTRACT NO. RP730
AMENDMENT NO. 6**

THIS CONTRACT as entered into on the 27th day of May, 2011, and amended on the 18th day of July, 2011, the 24th day of May, 2012, on the 26th day of April, 2013, on the 17th day of June 2014, and on the 3rd day of June, 2015 between the STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION (hereinafter referred to as the "Department") and ST. JOHNS COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS (hereinafter referred to as the "County") is hereby amended as follows:

- Pursuant to paragraph 4, which provides for the addition of funding for each additional period of service, paragraph 4.A. is hereby revised to increase the compensation amount of the Contract from \$230,459.90 to \$271,099.76 (an increase for FY 15/16 of \$13,945.05 and for FY 16/17 of \$26,694.81) to cover the period of service from May 27, 2016 to September 5, 2016.
