

RESOLUTION 2017 - 259

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 COUNTY ATTORNEY BUDGET IN ORDER TO RECEIVE UNANTICIPATED REVENUE AND AUTHORIZE ITS EXPENDITURE BY THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY ATTORNEY'S OFFICE.

WHEREAS, the St. Johns County Attorney's Office has received an award of grant money toward hiring an intern for summer 2017; and

WHEREAS, these revenues were not anticipated during the preparation of the 2017 Fiscal Year Budget; and

WHEREAS, the revenue of \$750.00 is intended to be used toward the expenses associated with hiring an intern, and

WHEREAS, the recognition of these funds as current year revenues is required to enable their appropriation for their intended purposes;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that:

1. The above Recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution, and such Recitals are adopted as Findings of Fact.
2. The County Attorney's revenue and expenditure budgets shall be adjusted to account for unanticipated funds The Florida Bar, in the amount of \$750.00 for Fiscal Year 2017.
3. The St. Johns County Attorney's Office is authorized to use and expend such funds for the purposes expressed in this Resolution.
4. To the extent that there are typographical or administrative errors that do not change the tone, tenor, or concept of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without subsequent approval of the Board of County Commissioners.
