

RESOLUTION NO. 2019- 124

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO DEP CONTRACT NO. RP783 AMENDING THE MAXIMUM PAYMENT AVAILABLE UNDER THE CONTRACT AND PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT FOR LIFEGUARD SERVICES TO ANASTASIA STATE RECREATION AREA BETWEEN MAY 24, 2019 AND SEPTEMBER 2, 2019.

WHEREAS, St. Johns County (the County) entered into DEP Contract No. RP783 (the Contract) with the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection (the State) to provide lifeguards for the County to provide water surveillance and emergency response to Anastasia State Recreation Area for peak summer Season between Memorial Day weekend and Labor Day weekend; and

WHEREAS, the attached Contract Amendment No. 2 (the Amendment) provides for an increase to the maximum funding available under the agreement from \$100,000.00 to \$124,806.45 (an increase of \$4,806.45); and

WHEREAS, the Amendment amends the payment schedule under the Contract's scope of services to provide for payment for lifeguard services at the Anastasia State Recreation Area between May 24, 2019 and September 2, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the County has reviewed the terms of the Amendment and has determined that executing the Amendment serves a public purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County:

1. The above recitals are incorporated into this resolution by reference and are adopted as finding of fact in support of this resolution.
2. The Board of County Commissioners approves the terms, provisions, conditions, and requirements of Amendment No. 2 to Contract No. RP783 and authorizes the County Administrator, or his designee, to execute the amendment in substantially the same form as attached on behalf of the County.
3. To the extent that there are typographical or administrative errors that do not change the tone, tenor, or concept of this resolution, this resolution may be revised without subsequent approval by the Board of County Commissioners.
4. This resolution shall be effective upon its adoption by the Board of County Commissioners.

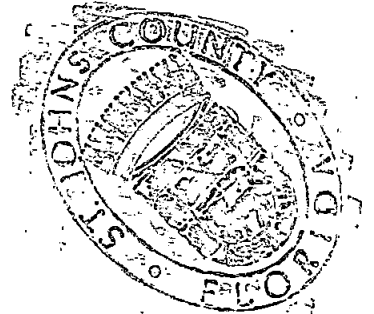

**AMENDMENT NO. 2
TO CONTRACT NO. RP783
BETWEEN
FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION
AND
ST. JOHNS COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS**

This Amendment to Contract No. RP783, as previously amended, (Contract) is made by and between the Department of Environmental Protection (Department), an agency of the State of Florida, and St. Johns County Board of County Commissioners 3657 Gaines Road, St. Augustine Beach, Florida 32084-6565 (Contractor), on the date last signed below.

WHEREAS, the Department entered into the Contract with the Contractor for the Contractor to provide lifeguard services for Anastasia State Park effective May 25, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend the Contract as set forth herein to increase the maximum compensation amount of the Contract and to revise the Payment Schedule.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

1. Paragraph 5.B. is hereby revised to increase the maximum compensation amount of the Contract from \$120,000.00 to \$124,806.45 (an increase of \$4,806.45) .
2. Attachment A, Scope of Services, Paragraph 3, Payment Schedule is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with following:
