

RESOLUTION NO. 2019- 163

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, RENAMING THE COUNTY ATTORNEY'S OFFICE LAW LIBRARY TO THE JAMES G. SISCO MEMORIAL LAW LIBRARY AND RECOGNIZING THE HARD WORK, DEDICATION AND COMMITMENT TO PUBLIC SERVICE OF FORMER COUNTY ATTORNEY JAMES G. SISCO; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, St. Johns County Resolution 1999-152, provides that the Board of County Commissioners has the authority to name public facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, in recognition of the hard work, dedication and commitment of public servants in St. Johns County whose efforts in developing, promoting and sustaining St. Johns County deserve special recognition; and

**WHEREAS**, James G. Sisco, served well and honorably for 27 years as St. Johns County Attorney, retiring in 2003; and

**WHEREAS**, in May 2013 the City, County and Local Government Law Section of The Florida Bar recognized and awarded James G. Sisco with the Ralph A. Marsicano Award for his significant and lasting career contributions to the development of local government law in Florida; and

**WHEREAS**, the Marsicano Award is the preeminent professional recognition granted to local government law practitioners in the State of Florida; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Sisco's achievements of state-wide application include recognition by the Florida Supreme Court of home rule authority of non-charter counties in the area of public finance; and

**WHEREAS**, the legal leadership of Mr. Sisco on public finance issues and the proper balance of first amendment rights and public safety and welfare were of great benefit to St. Johns County and the State of Florida; and

**WHEREAS**, the public service career of James G. Sisco included service not only to St. Johns County but also to the United States Army in a manner that exemplifies the professionalism, dedication to duty, and standard of achievement of what a public servant should be, to present and future generations; and

**WHEREAS**, it is fitting and in the public interest to memorialize the name of James G. Sisco as a role model and substantial contributor to the public health, safety, and welfare of St. Johns County, and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners finds it to be in the public interest to change the current name of the St. Johns County Attorney's Office Law Library to the James G. Sisco Memorial Law Library.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida that, effective immediately:

1. The above Recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution, and such Recitals are adopted as findings of fact.
2. The law library formerly known as St. Johns County Attorney's Office Law Library is hereby renamed to James G. Sisco Memorial Law Library;
