**A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO APPROVE A.W.A. CONTRACTING COMPANY, INC TASK ORDER NO. 25 FOR DRAINAGE PIPE REPLACEMENTS AT TEN (10) CROSSINGS ON JOE ASHTON ROAD UNDER BID NO. 18-14 (MASTER CONTRACT NO. 17-MCC-AWA-08972)**

RECITALS

**WHEREAS**, On January 31, 2018, the County entered into a task order based continuing services contract with A.W.A. Contracting Company, Inc; and;

**WHEREAS**, the contract requires approval from the St. Johns County Board of County Commissioners on all task orders greater than \$200,000; and;

**WHEREAS**, the Engineering Dept. has a need to issue a task order to A.W.A. Contracting Company, Inc for the replacement of drainage pipes at ten (10) crossings on Joe Ashton Road, which will total \$505,107.64; and;

**WHEREAS**, the task order will be funded through the FY 2020 Countywide Drainage Infrastructure; and;

**WHEREAS**, the County has reviewed the terms, provisions, conditions and requirements of the proposed task order (attached hereto, an incorporated herein) and finds that executing the task order to complete the work services serves a public purpose; and;

**WHEREAS**, the task order will be in substantial conformance with the attached draft task order.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA**, as follows:

Section 1. The above Recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution and such Recitals are adopted as finds of fact.

Section 2. The County Administrator, or designee, is hereby authorized to issue a task order to A.W.A. Contracting Company, Inc to provide the services set forth therein.

Section 3. The County Administrator, or designee, is further authorized to execute a task order in substantially the same form and format as the attached draft on behalf of the County to provide the scope of services as specifically provided in the task order.

Section 4. To the extent that there are typographical and/or administrative errors that do not change the tone, tenor, or concept of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without subsequent approval by the Board of County Commissioners.

### SCOPE OF WORK:

Task Order #25 is hereby issued to authorize A.W.A. Contracting Co., Inc. ("Contractor"), construct drainage repairs for ten (10) crossings located on Joe Ashton Road by removing and replacing existing drainage pipes as stated in the Contractor's proposal dated October 15, 2019, and attached hereto. The authorized work shall generally include the following tasks: MOT; erosion control; floating turbidity barrier; clearing and grubbing; removal of existing pipe; removal of existing headwall; concrete removal; stripe removal; asphalt pavement removal; unclassified/unsuitable excavation with haul off; install new reinforced concrete pipe (RCP) and new elliptical reinforced concrete pipe (ERCP); install new straight end walls, precast endwalls, and headwalls; fill A-3 Sand or better; flowable fill; rip rap; limerock; #57 stone; install 66: concrete driveway; roadway shoulder regrading; ditch regrading; asphalt patch repair; grassing/sod; and sign relocation.

### PAYMENT TERMS:

The County shall compensate the Contractor, under Task Order #25, a not-to-exceed amount of five hundred five thousand one hundred seven dollars and sixty-four cents (\$505,107.64), based on unit prices, and actual quantities, for work satisfactorily completed in accordance with the provisions of this task order, and with the Master Contract dated January 31, 2018.

### SCHEDULE:

The County shall issue a Notice to Proceed to the Contractor upon receipt of a recorded Public Construction Bond. Work shall commence upon receipt of the Notice to Proceed and shall be completed **within one hundred sixty (160) consecutive calendar days from the date of the Notice to Proceed**. The Effective Date of this Task Order shall be the date of signature by an authorized St. Johns County Representative. Any work performed prior to full execution of this Task Order shall be at the Consultant's Own Risk.
