

RESOLUTION 2020- 276

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION (FTA) GRANTS AND TO RECOGNIZE THE REVENUES IN THE 2020 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET FOR THE OPERATION AND PURCHASE OF VEHICLES FOR THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the Federal Transit Administration has been authorized under Chapter 53, Title 23 of the United States Code to award federal public transportation funding assistance; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County seeks to submit an application to the Federal Transit Administration, seeking a Federal Transit Administration Section 5307 Urbanized Area Grant in the amount of \$2,143,338, combined with Section 5339(b) Bus and Bus Facilities Program grants in the amount of \$943,338 for public transportation funding assistance; and

WHEREAS, this allotment is designated for the operation, maintenance and purchase of buses for St. Johns County Public Transportation; and

WHEREAS, these funds are referenced in the State Transportation Improvement Program reference numbers 406789-9, 429203-3, 441522-1, and

WHEREAS, to receive these funds a Federal Transit Administration Section 5307/5339 grant must be submitted; and

WHEREAS, as required by Federal Transit Administration guidelines, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County must conduct a public hearing to consider and approve a Program of Projects prior to application submittal to serve as the basis for the requested funding; and

WHEREAS, the County's matching funds for the \$955,000 in Operating will come a Florida Department of Transportation block grant and from the County's \$276,489 annual contribution to public transportation; and

WHEREAS, the 20% matching funds for capital will come from the State of Florida in the form of transportation development credits; and

WHEREAS, once approved by the Federal Transit Administration the grant will be executed by St. Johns County; and

WHEREAS, the \$2,143,338 in Federal Transit Administration funding will be recognized in the 2020 fiscal year budget; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that:

1. The above recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this resolution and such recitals are adopted as findings of fact.
2. The Board of County Commissioners hereby approves submission of Section 5307/5339 Grant application for \$2,143,338 and the revenue from this grant will be included in St Johns County's 2020 fiscal year budget.

3. As required, the Board of County Commissioners considered the proposed Program of Projects during a public hearing and hereby approves the same. The Program of Projects shall be included in the grant agreement as the basis for the requested funding.
4. The 50% match for \$955,000 in Operating will come from a Florida Department of Transportation block grant and the County's annual contribution to transit, of \$276,489.
5. The 20% match for \$1,252,085 in Capital will come from Transportation Development Credits provided by the State of Florida.
6. Upon approval of the application, the County Administrator, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute the grant agreement, along with any required supplemental documentation, on behalf of the County.
7. To the extent that there are typographical or administrative errors that do not change the tenor, tone or concept of this resolution, then this resolution may be revised without subsequent approval of the Board of County Commissioners.

Any evidence, testimony, and argument which is offered utilizing CMT shall be afforded equal consideration as if were offered in person and shall be subject to the same objections.
