

RESOLUTION NO. 2020 384

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR OR DESIGNEE TO TRANSFER FUND BALANCE FROM THE UTILITY AUTHORITY FUND TO THE GENERAL FUND AND APPROPRIATE FUNDS WITHIN THE FISCAL YEAR 2021 COUNTY BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the County established the Utility Authority and to regulate rates and service areas provided by private utility companies within the county; and

WHEREAS, the County collected regulatory fees in a special revenue from privately owned utilities operating within the County; and

WHEREAS, since the Authority's inception most of the private utilities have been dissolved or acquired by the County Utility department; and

WHEREAS, the fund has not collected any such regulatory fees since Fiscal Year 2009; and


WHEREAS, the Office of Management and Budget requests to transfer the balance remaining in the fund to the County's General Fund reserves for future appropriation.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida:

1. The above recitals are hereby adopted as legislative findings of fact and incorporated herein.
2. The Board of County Commissioners authorizes the County Administrator or his designee to initiate a budget transfer of the balance of the Utility Authority Fund to the General Fund reserves.
3. The Board of County Commissioners approves the transfer of Utility Authority Fund Balance to General Fund reserves.
4. To the extent there are typographical errors that do not substantively change the tone, tenor, or concept of this resolution, this resolution may be revised without subsequent approval by the Board of County Commissioners.
