

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-240



ADOPTED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, this 15<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2021.

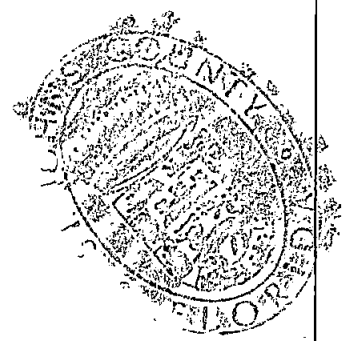
