

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-342




and the notice required by Section 336.10, Florida Statutes, is hereby authorized and directed to be published.

Exhibit A

All of the unnamed 25' street lying on the most southerly boundary of Anastasia Park as recorded in Map Book 3, Page 65 of the public records of St. Johns County, Florida. Said street being bounded on the east by State Road No. A1A as now established and bounded on the west by the southerly prolongation of the westerly right of way line of Oleander Street. Said west boundary is also being the east line of that portion of the street vacated per St. Johns County Board of County Commissioners – Resolution No. 2007-23 recorded in Official Records 2857, Page 471 of said public records.
