

RESOLUTION NO. 2022- 1101

**A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE TERMS AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE AMENDMENT NO. 5 TO CONTRACT BETWEEN THE COUNTY AND THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION FOR THE COUNTY TO CONTINUE TO PROVIDE LIFEGUARD SERVICES FOR ANASTASIA STATE PARK FOR THE PEAK SUMMER SEASON.**

**WHEREAS**, St. Johns County (“County”) and Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) entered into DEP Contract No. RP783 (“Contract”), effective May 25, 2017, to provide lifeguard services through St. Johns County Marine Rescue for Anastasia State Park for the peak summer season between Memorial Day weekend and Labor Day weekend; and

**WHEREAS**, the Contract provides that DEP may increase the funding amount from year to year based on satisfactory performance and annual appropriations by the Florida Legislature; and

**WHEREAS**, Amendment No. 5 to the Contract increases the funding amount from \$204,690.83 to \$253,530.42 (an increase of \$48,839.59) to cover the period for lifeguard services from May 27, 2022 through September 5, 2022.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA**, as follows:

**Section 1.** The above recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution and are adopted as findings of fact.

**Section 2.** The Board of County Commissioners hereby approves the terms, provisions, conditions, and requirements of Amendment No. 5 to DEP Contract No. RP783 and authorizes the County Administrator, or designee, to execute said Amendment on behalf of St. Johns County substantially in the same form as attached hereto.

**Section 3.** To the extent there are typographical, scrivener, or administrative errors or omissions that do not change the tone, tenor, or context of this Resolution, Amendment No. 5 may be revised without subsequent approval by the Board of County Commissioners.

**Section 4.** This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption by the Board of County Commissioners.



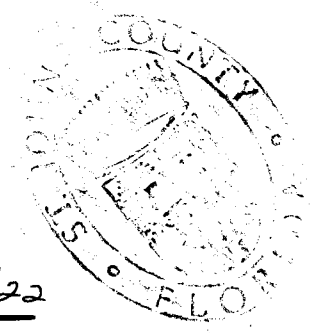

**AMENDMENT NO. 5  
TO CONTRACT NO. RP783  
BETWEEN  
FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION  
AND  
ST. JOHNS COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS**

This Amendment to Contract No. RP783, as previously amended, (Contract) is made by and between the Department of Environmental Protection (Department), an agency of the State of Florida, and St. Johns County Board of County Commissioners, 3657 Gaines Road, St. Augustine Beach, FL 32084-6565 (Contractor), on the date last signed below.

WHEREAS, the Department entered into the Contract with the Contractor to provide lifeguard services through the St. Johns County Marine Rescue for Anastasia State Park effective May 25, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend the Contract as set forth herein.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

1. Paragraph 5.B is hereby revised to increase the maximum compensation amount of the Contract from \$204,690.83 to \$253,530.42 (an increase of \$48,839.59).
2. Attachment A, Scope of Services, Paragraph 3, Payment Schedule, is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
