

RESOLUTION NO. 2022 - 374

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTED CONTRACT AMENDMENTS WITH A.W.A. CONTRACTING CO, INC., CONSTANTINE CONSTRUCTORS, INC., AND G&H UNDERGROUND CONSTRUCTION, INC. TO AMEND ARTICLE 4.1.1 PROJECT PRICE UNDER BID NO. 18-14; COUNTYWIDE ROADWAY DRAINAGE & INFRASTRUCTURE MAINTENANCE IN ACCORDANCE WITH NEW PROCUREMENT THRESHOLDS UNDER THE SJC PURCHASING POLICY.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, in January 2018, the County entered in to contracts with A.W.A. Contracting Co., Inc., Constantine Constructors, Inc., and G&H Underground Construction, Inc. for provision of construction services for Countywide Roadway Drainage & Infrastructure Maintenance under Bid No. 18-14; and

WHEREAS, Contract Article 4.1.1 Project Price specified "The County shall pay, and the Contractor shall accept, as full and complete payment for all Work required by each Task Order, the amount specified and authorized by each Task Order upon satisfactory completion of the required Work for each project. The amount set forth in each Task Order shall not exceed two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000), without prior written authorization by the Board of County Commissioners."

WHEREAS, on July 1, 2022, the new SJC Purchasing Policy was issued as adopted by Ordinance # 2022-22 increasing the procurement threshold requiring Board of County Commissioners approval for contracts to \$500,000.

WHEREAS, the County desires to amend the contracts under Bid No. 18-14 to revise Article 4.1.1 Project Price in accordance with the new procurement authorization thresholds per the SJC Purchasing Policy as follows: "The County shall pay, and the Contractor shall accept, as full and complete payment for all Work required by each Task Order, the amount specified and authorized by each Task Order upon satisfactory completion of the required Work for each project. County approval of Task Orders shall be in accordance with the approval thresholds stated in Section 4 of the SJC Purchasing Policy."

WHEREAS, the County finds that executing contract amendments revising Article 4.1.1 Project Price in accordance with the new procurement authorization thresholds per the SJC Purchasing Policy serves a public purpose, and the contract amendment will be in substantial conformance with the attached draft.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

Section 1. The above Recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution and such Recitals are adopted as finds of fact.

Section 2. The County Administrator, or designee, is hereby authorized to executed contract amendments to the existing contracts under Bid No. 18-14 with A.W.A. Contracting Co., Inc., Constantine Constructors, Inc., and G&H Underground Construction, Inc. revising Article 4.1.1 Project Price in accordance with the new procurement authorization thresholds per the SJC Purchasing Policy.

Section 3. To the extent that there are typographical and/or administrative errors that do not change the tone, tenor, or concept of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without subsequent approval by the Board of County Commissioners.

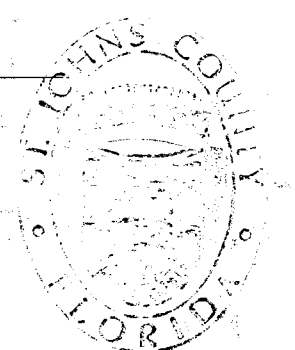
